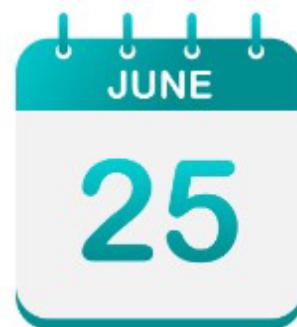

Beyond Kern's 6 Steps: Curricular Design for the Advanced Educator

The grid contains 67 slides, numbered 13 to 67. Key topics include:

- Organophosphates:** Mechanism of Action, Multiple Routes of Absorption (Respiratory, Conjunctival, GI, Dermal), Inhibit Acetylcholinesterase (Muscarinic, Nicotinic, CNS).
- Atropine:** Will Atropine work on Nicotinic receptors? (No!), Reverses Ach-E phosphorylation, Administer ASAP.
- Physostigmine:** Contraindicated if QRS.
- Methamphetamine:** First Synthesized: Japan in 1893, World War II, Distributed to German troops as "Pervitin", Effects: Euphoria, heightened attention, increased energy, decreased anxiety, Diaphoresis, fatigue, restlessness, anorexia, irritability.
- Other topics:** Sanni (Tokyo), Anticholinergics / Anticholinergics, Antihistamines / Anticholinergics, Anticholinergics / Anticholinergics, Antikote, Sympathetic Stimulation, Sympathetic vs. Anticholinergic, Methamphetamine (Blocks Serotonin re-uptake, Stimulates Dopamine and Norepinephrine release).
