## Chancellor Update

He will also be awarded the title of Chair Emeritus.

Dr. Flotte thanked UMass Memorial for providing COVID vaccine to medical school individuals who are in appropriate categories. Invitations went out to medical students, first responders, and and researchers who are working on COVID-facing research. The remainder of the students who are doing volunteer and/or other imbedded activities to a lesser extent in a health care setting have now been invited. The remainder of the on-site medical school work-force will be worked into the UMass Memorial allocation as vaccine becomes available. UMass Medical School employees working solely from home will be included in the "patient" group, which has not begun yet.
