## STANDING REPORTS

## Dean & Provost Update

The COVID positivity rate numbers in the hospital are high due to the Omicron surge. The Medical Center's testing center reported an over 40% positivity rate among symptomatic patients and 20% positivity rate among asymptomatic patients. In the school, numbers are not as high. However, all didactic sessions are remote for the weeks of January 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>.

The Medical School's on-site testing center has is a cap of 575 tests per date that they can accept each day.

Students are being tested twice per week. For the foreseeable future, students will be tested at the testing center once per week and will be given an at home test to use for their second test. The at-home tests are being provided by a state contract.

#### Vice Provost for Faculty Affairs Update

We're relaunching the New Faculty Orientation on Zoom. Our hope is to eventually move back to an in-person event. However, since that is not possible currently, we're planning a high impact event for new faculty on January 11, 2022, from 8-10 am on Zoom. Future orientation sessions will be offered on a quarterly basis. Provost Flotte and Chancellor Collins will be at the event. Any faculty, even if they are not new, are welcome to attend.

Dr. Ahn provided an overview of the planned agenda. The format is changing a bit from those offered in years past. This shorter will event will provide attendees with a tasting menu/overview of the UMass Chan Medical School and UMass Memorial Health Care. In between scheduled orientation programs, faculty can view resources on the Office of Faculty Affairs website such as: slides from the orientation program, documents, and training session videos. An email invitation will be sent out to the Faculty Council membership. All interested faculty are welcome to attend the event.
