STANDING REPORTS

Chancellor Updates

Dr. Collins announced that the UMass Lowell Chancellor, Jacquie Moloney, is retiring this month after nearly four decades of service to the campus. She took part in her last Board of Trustees meeting as Chancellor today and received a tremendous outpouring of support.

Dr. Collins announced that the UMass Board met for a special meeting, where it was announced Julie Chen, Ph.D., currently Vice Chancellor for Research and Innovation at Lowell, would be succeeding Chancellor Moloney.

Dr. Collins announced that Chancellor Subbaswamy announced his intention to step down following a national search for a new chancellor of the Amherst campus. Dr. Subbaswamy has ably led the flagship campus for the past decade.

Dr. Collins announced the Board of Trustees approved the appointments to endowed chairs of the following three faculty members:

- Eric H. Baehrecke, PhD, Professor of Molecular, Cell and Cancer Biology, for appointment to the *Our Danny Cancer Fund Chair in Biomedical Research*
- Alan Mullen, MD, PhD, incoming Professor of Medicine and Academic Chief of Gastroenterology, for appointment to the *Mary C. DeFeudis Chair in Biomedical Research*.
- Jeanne B. Lawrence, MS, PhD, Professor of Neurology and Pediatrics, for appointment to the *Leo P. and Theresa M. LaChance Chair in Medical Research*.

We now have 62 endowed chairs in total, 59 being occupied, 20 of which are women faculty. While we need to continue to do better, I am heartened to see the dramatic increase in women faculty being appointed to endowed chairs over the course of the last decade.
