# STANDING REPORTS

### Dean & Provost Update

Dr. Flotte announced that the new VA Ambulatory Center should be opening sometime during the month of November sometime during week of Veterans Day. The construction of the new research building is ahead of schedule and should be complete by December 2022.

# Search Updates:

- Director of Human Genetics- One candidate for the founding Director of the new program in Human Genetics and the GI Division chief.
- Chair of Biochemistry- Should be completed by mid-to-late September
- Chair of Neurology- Still in the early stages of the search for the Chair of Neurology.

Dr. Flotte reminded everyone of the deadline for uploading proof of COVID-19 vaccination or medical or religious exemption for Medical School employees and students. It is September 7, 2021. Non-clinical building access will be rescinded for non-compliance.

Anyone who is on-campus one day or more per week must participate in surveillance testing for COVID-19.

## Vice Provost for Faculty Affairs Update

Dr. Ahn gave a presentation on the future of Faculty Affairs which included:

- Providing an update on the roll-out of new faculty development initiatives.
- OFA is offering two professional development programs for faculty Junior Faculty Development Program and the AALANA faculty network which is co-sponsored by the Diversity and Inclusion office and Office of Health Equity.
- OFA also offers two faculty leadership development and New Chair orientation and Vice Chair Orientation.



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- There will also be a refresh on the New Faculty Orientation event, DPAC Chair and Committee Training, Tenure Track Mentoring Program, Peers for Promotion, Empower (women's faculty seminars), Joy McCann Professorship (Mid-Career faculty development), and Conflict Management for Faculty seminars called Crucial Accountability.
- Some new ideas for professional development initiatives: Faculty co-led bystander training co-sponsored by Diversity and Inclusion Office, Faculty Vitality Program, Clinical Investigator coaching program, Junior Faculty Development Program Basic Science Faculty Track.
- On the Faculty Leadership side, OFA is also interested in establishing some new groups: Allyship Training co-sponsored with the Diversity and Inclusion Office, New Chair/Vice Chair Leadership Coaching Consultation and Assessment, New Vice Chair/ Peer Coaching Group, and Mid-Career Faculty Peer Coaching Group.
- The Office of Faculty Affairs' program implementation plan involves forming both a Faculty Development team and an Advisory group. Members of these new groups and Office of Faculty Affairs staff will work together to conduct needs assessment among faculty, creating programs by developing partnerships with several on-campus stakeholders, creating a catalog of faculty resources, and evaluating programs and services (both internal and external).
