Mary	Business processes will remain the same for whatever is carried out by each department post-Peoplesoft in terms of grading, etc.

	E-mail to be sent regarding evaluation and assessments from Michele C. This e-mail will include a request for some rotation-specific		
	information including the grading scale (final grading scale will be changed to a new rubric – Pass/Fail, Honors/High Honors to align with		
	other Medical Schools), site-based information regarding whether there are residents or only attendings, etc.		
	Homepage of OASIS; left navigation will list all courses/clerkships/Sub-Is that you oversee. Use the + and – symbol at the top of the left		
	navigation to expand or collapse the list view. Further (more specific) navigation and training materials will be released in the coming		
	weeks. Login will be single-sign on for those with a umassmed edu e-mail address. Those with a umassmemorial org will have a separate		
	username (could be their e-mail address, Michele to follow up on this) and password. However, evaluations will still have a direct link with		
	no login required included in the e-mail so that logins will only be required for any reporting or search purposes.		
	Generalized clerkship evaluation forms were agreed on by the Clerkship Directors committee – there will no longer be any clerkship-		
	specific questions on the Rotation, Site or Preceptor evaluation forms. (i.e. same forms will be used regardless of rotation specialty).		
	UMass residents will now be included in the automatic feed from PeopleSoft, though residents from other sites will not be included.		
	The Final Grade Report will maintain the current feed – final grades will be entered into the OASIS Grade Book.		
	Interim Grade Reports in OASIS are called Summary Evaluations; based on the assessments submitted, OASIS pre-populates the average scores.
