Application Specifics

The University of Massachusetts Neurological Surgery Residency is a seven-year ACGME-approved neurological surgery training program. The program accepts one categorical resident per year. This includes two years of research and academic time during the PGY-4 and PGY-5 years.

Required documents include:

- Completed ERAS Application
- USMLE Transcript (first-time pass is required)
- MSPE – Medical Student Performance Evaluation
- Applicants must also have passed USMLE Step II (CS and CK) before starting residency, as it is a requirement for Massachusetts licensure.
- Medical School Transcript
- Personal Statement
- Photograph
- ECFMG Certificate (if applicable)
- Citizenship/Visa Status
- 3 Letters of Recommendation

All required documents must be submitted through ERAS and will not be accepted outside of ERAS.

The institution accepts a standardized personal statement but suggests that applicants consider discussing attributes that will help foster the applicant's competence and resilience.
