



Hybrid-Enabled Rooms

A “hybrid-enabled” room consists of a podium where the presenter can host a Zoom meeting and broadcast the presentation to the screen in the room as well as share content directly with remote viewers. The room will also have a camera for the remote participant to interact and communicate with the people in the room. Optimally, the room will also have ceiling mics to ensure that remote participants have quality audio access to discussions, Q&A, and comments from all on-site participants.
