Fee Payment Schedule

All fees are paid by student's Thesis Advisor(s) and/or their department

GSBS Tuition

- Tuition is assessed until the student has completed 9 semesters in PhD studies - except MD/PhD students
- MD/PhD Students: Tuition is assessed until the student has completed 6 semesters in PhD studies

GSBS Program Fee

- Program Fee is assessed post completion of 9 semesters in PhD studies - except MD/PhD students
- MD/PhD Students: Program Fee is assessed post completion of 6 semesters in PhD studies

GSBS Student Services Fee

- Student Services Fee is assessed until the student graduates

GSBS Career Development Fee

- Career Development Fee is assessed until the student graduates

GSBS Health Fee

- Health Fee is assessed until the student graduates whether the student elects UMMS Health Insurance
- Health fee covers both Student Health Services and Student Counseling Services

Insurance Information

1. Health & Dental Insurance remain in effect until 08/31/20, even if the student leaves the University
2. The Fall Only rate is available only for students expecting to complete by 1/31/20
3. If the student fails to complete by 1/31/20, the Thesis Advisor will be responsible for paying the student's insurance for the balance of the year at a cost of \$,2,353.00.
4. The Spring Rate and Summer Rate are also for students who matriculate in the GSBS Spring or Summer Semesters
5. A student must be either active and registered or on a leave of absence to be eligible for health insurance
