CURRICULUM

The RN-to-BSN degree program is a total of 120 credits. Courses are required to fulfill general education requirements but can be transferred in from previous college coursework.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

The following is required of candidates wishing to be considered for admission to the RN-to-BSN program at Anna Maria College:

- Completed application
- Proof of unencumbered Registered Nurse license in state(s) of practice degree may be granted*
- Official transcripts conferring graduation from a state-approved, regionally-accredited (ASN graduates) or nationally accredited (diploma) nursing program
- Resume documenting current nursing employment and professional activities
- Two letters of recommendation
- International applicants: additional requirements may apply for students whose native language is not English
