FCE DESCRIPTION

The course is designed to introduce the student to an aspect of clinical infectious diseases in which the student has an interest. The emphasis of the attending will be to emphasize the fundamentals of the patient-physician encounter and the development of a working diagnosis and management plan. This will not be the place to brush up on ID topics. A general knowledge base will be expected and the encounters are geared to embody concepts with substance. Detailed knowledge of ID issues is not expected, but an interest in being a superb clinician is expected.
