FCE DESCRIPTION

During this one week experience, medical students will have the opportunity to interface with several UMass child psychiatrists and child fellows in a variety of clinical settings: emergency mental health, inpatient pediatric consultation-liaison, outpatient consultation to primary care and inpatient care. Students will have 1:1 supervision from core child psych faculty on working with children, families and systems of care. The medical student will also have opportunity to participate in didactics and seminars when appropriate. Medical students who are interested in learning more about child psychiatry, pediatrics or family systems are encouraged to apply.

By the end of this session, students should be able to explain a variety of levels of care involved in treating youth/families with mental health needs. Also, students should be able to describe the various roles that child psychiatrists play in assessment, treatment and consultation.
