FCE DESCRIPTION

The student will participate in the care of patients with a wide variety of gastrointestinal and liver diseases. During one week, the student will have the opportunity to see patients in multiple settings. These will include (1) outpatient endoscopic procedures in both the hospital and the ambulatory procedure center, (2) the outpatient clinic in both a general gastroenterology office setting and University inflammatory bowel disease clinic setting, and (3) spend one day on the inpatient GI consult service at Memorial. Students will be expected to perform history and physical exams on patients in all settings and participate in drafting consultation reports during the day on the inpatient consult service. In addition, the student will be expected to review and briefly present one major article (chosen together with the attending) in the field of gastroenterology during the week long elective
