Day One Instructions	Approximately one week prior to the first FCE, email Peter Foley: peter.foley@umassmed.edu indicating that the student is scheduled for the Pediatric Anesthesiology FCE. On first day of the FCE, report to the University campus Operating Room Control Board at approximately 6:50. Introduce yourself to the Anesthesiologist In Charge (AIC). Scrubs are required. If the student needs assistance with scrubs, contact the charge nurse of the OR.

FCE DESCRIPTION

Students will be assigned each day to an operating room or radiology suite in which a pediatric procedure is to take place. They will work with the attending anesthesiologist and the anesthesia resident or nurse anesthetist.

FCE LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- be able to perform a basic preoperative evaluation for a baby or child
- learn basic anesthesia techniques in the pediatric population including mask ventilation, airway management, IV catheter placement
- understand the differences in physiology and anesthetic pharmacology in the baby and child as compared to the adult
- participate in the care of pediatric patients undergoing anesthesia for various procedures
