FCE DESCRIPTION

This course is identical to the one-week rotation in anesthesiology during the surgical clerkship and should not be taken in addition to it. It may be used as the prerequisite to the other FCEs offered by the Department of Anesthesiology.

FCE LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- perform a basic anesthetic pre-operative evaluation
- formulate a basic anesthetic management plan for a healthy patient undergoing routine surgery
- formulate a rational plan for perioperative fluid management
- formulate a safe plan for airway management
- demonstrate familiarity with basic airway management skills including: mask ventilation, LMA placement, and direct laryngoscopy for endotracheal intubation
- demonstrate familiarity with intravenous catheter placement
- function appropriately in the operating suite as a member of the anesthesia care team
- recognize the emphasis anesthesiologists place on patient safety
