FCE DESCRIPTION

Students will follow attending radiation oncologists and see their patients; this may mean primarily seeing a particular disease site, such as breast, prostate or GYN, or general practice of radiation oncology. All such experiences are likely to include palliative cases as well as curative ones. Students are expected to keep a journal, and attend tumor boards and chart rounds. They will present a minimum of 1 case to an attending physician. If more than 2 students choose this elective at a time, 1 will be assigned to the Memorial campus.
