#### FCE DESCRIPTION

The UMass Memorial Sports Medicine Clinic is a high-volume center that treats patients of all ages and abilities. Here, the student will gain an appreciation for the scope of a Sports Medicine practice in a community setting. Through clinical exposure and community involvement, the student will learn about joint anatomy, the importance of history of injury, physical evaluation skills, common injuries and their diagnoses, and common procedures used in a clinical setting.

#### FCE LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- demonstrate knowledge of pertinent anatomy and common musculoskeletal injuries seen in clinic
- perform a full evaluation of the shoulder, knee, and ankle
- use the history of injury and the musculoskeletal exam as a diagnostic tool
- understand common procedures used in clinic, including splinting, injections, and ultrasound
