FCE DESCRIPTION

During the week will work with 1-2 attendings at the health center seeing regularly scheduled adult patients. Visits will include history and physicals, follow-up appointments, and urgent care visits. Most patients will be seen first by the student who will then present the case to the attending, after which the patient will be evaluated by both caregivers together. Teaching will be case-based, and will involve evidence based medicine, physical exam skills, presentation skills, development of management plans, and patient-physician relationships. Students may be directed to other attendings who have interesting cases/physical exam findings that day as well.

FCE LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Become familiar with the structure of an outpatient visit, including the Well Physical, follow up appointment, and urgent care visit
- Improve history taking skills for both the focused problem and general health visit
- Improve physical exam skills for the acute visit and general physical exam
- Demonstrate use of evidence-based medicine in the management of acute and chronic disease
