FCE DESCRIPTION

Medicine consult at university is performed by hospitalists. the goals are identifying unrecognized comorbid disease and risk factors for medical complications of surgery and optimizing the preoperative medical condition. Two common practices are peri operative cardiovascular risk stratification and co-management with orthopedic surgery for patients with hip fracture. Other areas that we also provide consult are : managing anticoagulation in atrial fibrillation and mechanical heart valves.
