FCE DESCRIPTION

Students will get an understanding of how cancers of the thorax and abdomen present and how they are staged to allow formulation of treatment plans. The rationale for multi-disciplinary care for complex oncologic disease will be explored as will the rationale for patient selection for aggressive combined modality treatment regimes. Students will attend Tumour Board Rounds, see patients in Multi-Disciplinary clinics, and attend in the operating room.
