FCE DESCRIPTION

The FCE student will spend one week at the Family Health Center of Worcester learning about a model of integrated primary, HIV, and viral hepatitis care. The student will participate in clinic sessions including both primary and specialty HIV/hepatitis care, HIV/Hepatitis fellow time, HIV and Hepatitis multidisciplinary team meetings.
