## FCE DESCRIPTION

This course will allow students to understand the role of a generalist obstetrician/gynecologist in a community practice, the setting where the majority of generalist OB GYNs work after residency. The week will include office and hospital time. In the office, the student will see a variety of patients with both OB and GYN issues. Typically 1 day will be spent on-call covering labor and delivery, and possibly time in the OR assisting with gynecological surgery. The community setting allows the student interested in OB GYN to see a different practice model than what most see during their third year clerkship. We will also spend time talking and thinking about different practice models and the business ideas behind each model. While not a true private practice, our model is similar, and will expose the student to issues like advocating for patients, working with insurers, understanding cost of treatments and different reimbursement models.

## FCE LEARNING OBJECTIVES

By the end of the week, the student should have an understanding of the different practice models, practice settings, and overall responsibilities and duties of the generalist obstetrician/gynecologist practicing in the community.
