FCE DESCRIPTION

Students will rotate on the gynecologic oncology service where they will help care for inpatients on the gyn oncology service, go to the OR on most days, and evaluate outpatients presenting to the office in a busy gynecologic oncology practice with 4 attendings. The gynecologic oncology service is the busiest gyn surgery service and in the operating room students will be incorporated into the surgical team for a full range of gynecologic oncology procedures including minimally invasive and robotic procedures, radical dissections for debulking of cancers and vulvar and vaginal surgery including laser. The outpatient experience is just as busy and varied with excellent volume of pelvic exams done by students and office procedures. Students will see outpatients presenting for chemotherapy, radiation or surgical treatment plans and be actively involved in our weekly gyn oncology tumor board where complex treatment plans are made. This multidisciplinary conference includes review of patient cases with input by radiation oncology, radiology, genetics and pathology. In some rotations students will be involved in palliative care planning and treatment as well.

- Describe the diagnosis and initial workup of the most common types of gynecologic cancers
- Understand the most common surgical treatments for gynecologic cancers
- Be able to perform a history and focused exam including pelvic exam on a patient with gynecologic cancer who presents for outpatient evaluation
- Present a gynecologic cancer patient at a multidisciplinary tumor board for treatment recommendations
