FCE DESCRIPTION

The Division of Gastroenterology offers a one-week elective for third year UMass Medical students. The objective of the rotation will be for students to gain exposure to the field of gastroenterology, and to introduce some of the basic clinical concepts in gastroenterology. The elective will take place at the Memorial campus and will include observation of the typical inpatient and outpatient activities of a practicing gastroenterologist. Specifically, the student will observe outpatient procedures such as upper endoscopy and colonoscopy, outpatient clinic visits, and will follow the gastroenterology fellow and attending while seeing inpatient consults and procedures.
