FCE DESCRIPTION

This course will be an introduction to the care of the critically ill medical patient. Common problems treated in these patients include sepsis and acute respiratory failure. The student will observe multidisciplinary rounding which includes physicians, nurse, pharmacist and respiratory therapist. Students may have the opportunity to observe procedures in the medical ICU such as central line placement and intubation.
