FCE DESCRIPTION

Students will attend the outpatient pediatric endocrine clinic daily where they will work with an attending pediatric endocrinologist to see a variety of endocrine disorders including disorders of growth, puberty, thyroid, adrenal gland and diabetes. Students will have the opportunity to shadow a certified diabetes educator to gain experience in diabetes education.

- Differentiate between normal and abnormal growth patterns
- Learn about the newborn screening test and the diagnosis of congenital hypothyroidism
