FCE DESCRIPTION

The student will spend their time on the colorectal service in a combination of the outpatient, inpatient and endoscopy setting. They will have the opportunity to work with all faculty in the division of colorectal surgery, and take part in all educational conferences during their elective, including the weekly multidisciplinary GI tumor board. They will shadow an attending surgeon each day, participating in outpatient clinic, inpatient rounds, and going to the operating room or endoscopy suite. Students will have exposure to the range of operative procedures performed by colorectal surgeons, from anorectic surgery to complex open and laparoscopic abdominal procedures. Overall, this elective is designed to provide the student with the opportunity to learn what life is like as a colorectal surgeon to help them determine if this is a career choice that might interest them.

- Understand the common medical conditions that will present for and require treatment by a colorectal surgeon, including colorectal cancer
- Be able to perform a history and physical on an outpatient presenting with a colorectal illness
- Observe and participate in outpatient, inpatient and endoscopy procedures when appropriate
- Describe the appropriate initial workup for a patient presenting for evaluation in the outpatient colorectal setting
