#### FCE DESCRIPTION

This experience is designed to give third year students the opportunity to act as radiology residents in several different spheres. Through the week, students will be oriented and trained to use the radiology-specific dictation software Nuance PowerScribe® 360; given access to patient imaging modalities such as radiograph, ultrasound, and CT; and assigned cases to interpret and sign out to an attending physician. This hands-on approach to reading and interpreting cases models how radiology residents learn. Additionally, FCE students will rotate through the Musculoskeletal and Emergency divisions to get a sense of the daily routine of residents and attendings at UMass.

#### FCE LEARNING OBJECTIVES

By the end of this weeklong session, students will...

- Know the major differences between radiographs, ultrasound, and CT, and provide some scenarios when a physician would order each type
- Become familiar with the language of radiology as it applies to the cases reviewed by the student
- Explain what they see in each case and list potential differentials based on their findings
- Navigate Nuance PowerScribe® 360 relatively efficiently
- Become comfortable presenting findings to attendings
