<b>Year 1</b> Total: ~20hrs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Global Health Pathway Sessions, monthly</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Topics include Global burden of disease, social/economic determinants of health, Refugee and Immigrant health, healthcare in low-resource settings, global health ethics, travel preparedness</li> <li>○ Co-leaders help pick articles for journal club discussions</li> <li>○ Community engagement and advocacy</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Summer between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Global health immersion experience</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ 6-8 weeks to a partner site</li> <li>○ Ensure travel is registered and pre-travel prep is completed</li> <li>○ Poster session upon return</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Year 2</b> Total: ~20hrs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Global Health Pathway Sessions, monthly</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Topics include health and human rights, healthcare delivery models, cultural and ethical issues in GH, careers in global health</li> <li>○ Capstone project/mentor identification and mentorship from MS3/MS4s</li> <li>○ Global Health Service Project: required service time of 10 hours/month</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Year 3</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Attend monthly Global Health Seminar series</li> <li>• Mentorship program with MS1s/MS2s</li> <li>• FCE opportunities</li> </ul>
<b>Year 4 *</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Capstone project</u>: GHP students complete their Capstone or longitudinal project on a topic related to global health</li> <li>• <u>Elective abroad (IMEP)</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Opportunities to travel abroad during MS4</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Years 1 to 4</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Global health journal club</u>: GHP students learn from reading and discussing articles, reports and other sources related to global health topics.</li> <li>• <u>Capstone Project</u>: GHP students choose a Capstone project or a longitudinal project on a topic related to global health</li> <li>• <u>Serve as teachers &amp; mentors to other students interested in global health</u>: GHP students have opportunities to act as mentors and teachers to students in previous years.</li> </ul>
