General Student Instructions/Requirements

(as provided to students)

- 1. A total of 12 precepting sessions are required for LPP throughout the first 18 months of medical school, Discovery Phase, Six sessions in the first twelve months and six in the last 6 months. Ideally one session every few weeks
- 2. After each visit, you will send a Work based assessment (WBA's) to your evaluator
- 3. You are **required** to call your preceptor to schedule an initial meeting (approximately 15-20 minutes) to arrange your schedule before you formally start seeing patients. **Contact your preceptor ASAP**, to schedule this first meeting. Ideally, this should occur before you start your first precepting session, but your preceptor may prefer to meet by having you arrive early on your first day.
 - Typically email or cell phone or both are the preferred method of communication with your preceptor but please discuss this with your preceptor. At the initial meeting, please review the course book and your educational goals with your preceptor.
- 4. Finally, it is important to recognize that although you are a student you are becoming a medical professional. You will be expected to dress and act accordingly. Please review the medical school's guidelines for professional behavior in the appendix prior to your first clinical encounter.
