

CURRICULUM RECIPROCITY UNDERSTANDING

The objective of this Curriculum Reciprocity Understanding (CRU) is to permit Worcester Polytechnic Institute (WPI) students to register for and attend University of Massachusetts Medical School Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences (GSBS) graduate level courses, and similarly to allow GSBS students to register for and attend WPI undergraduate and graduate level courses – all in order that the involved students might enhance their academic program.

Any student wishing to register for a course offered by the partnering campus must first obtain approval from their advisor and School Dean by demonstrating how the selected course would enhance the student's progress towards completion of their educational degree/program. The student must then obtain approval from the partner campus course director and School Dean. If seating for a course is limited, students of the host campus will be given preference in registration.

The Registrar's and Bursar's Offices of each Institution, in collaboration with the appropriate Deans, shall develop the necessary procedures to implement the objectives of this CRU, including but not limited to, addressing the number of guest students who will be permitted to register at each campus and the processes for cross-registration and tuition/fee waivers. These policies must be reviewed and approved by the Provosts of each institution.

This CRU will become operable on September 1, 2017 and will continue for a period of five (5) consecutive years terminating on August 31, 2022, unless terminated by either Party by giving thirty (30) days' notice in writing to the other Party. The provisions of this CRU may be amended, modified and/or changed only by a written document mutually entered into and executed by authorized representatives of GSBS and WPI, as circumstances may require.
