



## Add a Link to the Left Navigation


The flowing instructions describe how to add a left navigation link to this resource within a course.

- 1. Make sure that **Edit Mode** is on.
- 2. Click on the **plus sign** at the top of the left navigation. Select **Tool Link** in the drop-down list:
- 3. The following dialog box will appear:






4. In the drop-down list next to **Type**, select **Atomic Learning**:


## Add an Atomic Learning Module to a Module Page

If you have a module page in your course, you may add Atomic Learning as another module on that page.


1. Navigate to your Module Page, then click on **Add Course Module** at the top of the page:
